

Data processing notice

The **National Toll Payment Services Private Company Limited by Shares** (registered office: 1134 Budapest, Váci út 45. B, company registration number: 01-10-043108, tax number: 12147715-2-44, e-mail: ugyfel@hu-go.hu (for cases related to the distance-based electronic toll system (HU-GO)) and ugyfel@nemzetiutdij.hu (for cases related to the time-based road use system); website: www.toll-charge.hu (hereinafter referred to as the “**website**”); phone number: **+36 (36) 587-500**; hereinafter referred to as **Data Controller**), is publishing the *summary tables* below in compliance with the relevant legislative provisions on the protection of personal data¹ and to provide an overview of its data processing activities. More detailed information, including the data processor used during data processing, is available in data processing statements available via separate interfaces (under the data privacy menu item of the website).

The Data Controller provides toll payment services to Hungarian public road users. The Data Controller is vigilant in protecting personal data, and shall ensure fair and transparent data processing at all time, the basic requirement for which is providing adequate information on data processing. The Data Controller provides information on its data processing in the course of providing its service: information on the source and scope of access to the processed data, contact details of the Data Protection Officer, the legal basis, purpose and duration of data processing, personal data rights and choices, and all contact information where the contracted toll payer, the road user and the motor vehicle operator (hereinafter: **User**) can receive answers to their questions regarding the Data Controller’s data protection processes.

The Data Controller’s data processing activities are as follows:

- registration on the website for cases related to the distance-based electronic toll system;
- registration on the website for cases related to the time-based road use system;
- customer service by phone, in person and in writing;
- claims for fines;
- imposing fines;
- toll collection operators;
- e-vignette purchases;
- toll collection;
- the use of cookies on the website;
- fulfillment of the document retention obligation.
