

NOTICE ON THE PROCESSING OF DATA

Dear Road Users,

The National Toll Payment Services Plc. (“NTPS Plc.”) due is appointed by law to perform toll enforcement activity. Relating to this obligation NTPS Plc. will carry out an inspection by a video camera in order to increase the efficiency of such toll enforcement activity and decrease the chance to miss or avoid toll-payment obligation.

NTPS Plc. will record the vehicles using the public road for approx. two weeks on 16 sites (see the attached list) for two hours per each site.

NTPS Plc. will select those registration numbers, which belong to the e-toll system (vehicles above 3,5 tons. Such selection will take 72 hours. Simultaneously, all camera records will be deleted. The selected registration numbers will be compared to the purchase data (only numbers!) of e-toll system. The entire data processing procedure takes 18 days from the date when the camera takes the relevant photos. Then all data will be deleted and only the result of the comparison will be used as statistical data in order to take the consequences necessary to the above mentioned increasement of efficiency.

Only the employees of NTPS Plc. will be involved in the data processing (members of the Project Directory of NTPS Plc.) with no access to the vehicle registration and the base of e-toll purchase data. Therefore any possibility to personalize the data under processing is excluded.

However mostly legal entities are effected in the e-toll system (so the relating vehicles data cannot be personal data), it seems to be necessary to publish this notice.

In the course of its data processing, NTPS Plc. is required to comply with the provisions of Act CXII of 2011 on informational self-determination and the freedom of information (Privacy Act), as well as of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation) as well as the provisions by the relevant sectoral and other civil law regulators.

Data to be processed are: registration number and nationality mark of the vehicle, the relating number of axles and e-toll category.

The natural person affected by the above data processing have the following rights and enforcement options:

1. **Right to information.** Pursuant to Article 15 (1) of the GDPR.
2. **Right to request a copy.** Pursuant to Article 15(3) and (4) of the GDPR, he/she may request a copy of his/her personal data processed by NTPS Plc.

3. **Right to rectification.** Pursuant to Article 16 of the GDPR, we will amend and rectify your personal data at his/her request.
4. **Right to restriction.** He/she may request the restriction of data processing in accordance with Article 18 of the GDPR.
5. **Common rules for the exercise of rights.** NTPS Plc. is able to act upon the request only during the 18 days long period of data processing. Please take it into consideration! If you need copy of the record of the camera, you can contact ugyfel@nemzetiutdij.hu e-mail address.

I. Enforcement options

If you believe that NTPS Plc.'s data processing is not in compliance with legal requirements, you may initiate proceedings with the National Authority for Data Protection and Freedom of Information (mailing address: H-1530 Budapest, Pf. 5, e-mail: ugyfelszolgalat@naih.hu).

Furthermore, you have the right to initiate court proceedings regarding the data processing practices of NTPS Plc. You may initiate such proceedings, at your discretion, at the court competent at your place of residence or place of stay.
